What is OSPF? (1 :) The Open Shortest Path First (OSPF) is an Interior Gateway Protocol (IGP) currently defined in RFC 2328. Offers many benefits such as: High scalability Extensibility Feature ...

As a link-state routing protocol, OSPF determines the shortest path between any two nodes using knowledge on the network topology, including the condition and price of network links.

The OSPF network belongs to Area 0, and is not connected to any other OSPF networks. All of the routers are part of the backbone 0.0.0.0 area, so no inter-area communications are needed.

Configure an IP address and enable IP forwarding (routing) on the backbone protected VLAN. OSPF is configured and because an OSPF broadcast network is used, configure the designated router and ...
