Before starting the installation, finding a proper place for putting the distribution box is crucial, because it largely decides the safety and convenience of maintenance. Let's see what factors ...

Elevators, dumbwaiters, escalators, moving walks, wheelchair lifts, and stairway chair lifts shall have a single means for disconnecting all ungrounded main power supply conductors for each unit.

Receptacles rated 15A and 20A, 125V located in pits, hoistways, on the cars of elevators, and in escalator and moving walk wellways must be of the GFCI type [Sec. 620.6].

On escalators and moving walks, the disconnecting means shall be installed in the space where the controller is located.

Generally, conductors and cables in or on an elevator or in the hoistway (other than traveling cables) must be installed in rigid metal conduit, intermediate metal conduit, electrical metallic tubing, rigid ...
