2.1 Cable tray systems shall be of the design of one manufacturer and shall be designed so that there are no burrs, projections, or sharp edges to damage cable insulation.

The tray shall be assembled by the use of a locking pin made of fiberglass reinforced thermoplastic. The locking pin shall be inserted under pressure with a high strength, chemical resistant adhesive.

The Ladder Tray features light, rugged, tubular steel construction. It is designed for mechanical support and strain relief in long runs of cable and creates a smooth gradual bend for cable.
