



# Fiber Optic Cable Core Test Specifications

Scope: This Standard specifies performance, transmission, and test and measurement requirements for premises optical fiber cable, connectors, connecting hardware, and patch cords.

Although most fiber optic cables are not conductive, any metallic hardware used in fiber optic cabling systems (such as wall-mounted termination boxes, racks, and patch panels) must be grounded.

The fibre complies with or exceeds IEC 60793-2-10 type A1b Optical Fiber Specification, ISO/IEC 11801 OM1 / OM2, TIA/EIA-492AAAA and Telcordia GR-20-CORE and GR-409-CORE Specifications.

Prior to installation, fiber inspections are performed to ensure that the fiber cables received from the manufacturer conform to the required specifications (length, attenuation, etc.) and have not been ...
