



Fiber Optic Cable Pole Spacing Standards

Fiber Optic Cable: A cable that contains individual glass fibers, designed for the transmission of digital information, using light pulses.

Fiber optic cable sequential numbers are required at each pole location and vault wall. Sequential numbers will identify conduit length, and slack left in vaults and at poles.

This document provides standards and guidelines for aerial installation of fiber optic cables including pole setting, grounding, cable runs between poles, and fiber optic cable handling.

Although most fiber optic cables are not conductive, any metallic hardware used in fiber optic cabling systems (such as wall-mounted termination boxes, racks, and patch panels) must be grounded.

These standards describe procedures and equipment for the installation and validation of fiber optic cables that carry signals for communications, security, device monitoring, and similar purposes.

These Standards are supplementary to the Licensee's Pole Attachment License Agreement ("Agreement"), and the Medina EC Pole Attachment Permitting Procedures, and supersede all other ...

Use Section 23 of the NESC to determine the clearances required at the pole and in-span. It specifies that the required vertical clearances must be measured surface-to-surface, not center-to-center. ...

**** Fiber Optic Cables in the supply space (Rule 224A) will have the same required clearance to communication cables in the communication space as a multi-grounded neutral (Rule 235C)**

Since building systems may require many types of cables, both fiber and copper, these cables should be separated to protect the fiber cables from damage and all cables marked properly.
