

How to place a full-reel optical cable

The cable reel should be placed well away from the first pole to prevent bending the cable excessively at the first pulley. The reel should have a brake to maintain significant tension as the cable is being ...

In general, fiber optic cable can be installed with many of the same techniques used with conventional copper cables. Basic guidelines that can be applied to any type of cable installation are as follows:

The bending radius of optical cable during laying process should be effectively guaranteed to avoid "gold hooks" and avoid too much tension, abrasion and too many times of twists and turns.

Refer to the cable specification sheet for the specific allowed tension for each cable. Coils are required for all ribbon gel-free and gel-filled armor cables that are in a butt-type closure any other closure, or ...

Avoid placing fiber optic cables in raceways and conduits with copper cables to avoid excessive loading or twisting. Attach cables with plastic clamps having large surface areas.
