Each powernet distribution box (PNDB) on the vehicle provides up to 4 low amperage circuits (30 amp and less), and up to three high amperage circuits through midi fuses. The fuses are located behind a ...

When the distribution box is in daily operation, with the passage of time, there will inevitably be failures, so for some common failures, some improvements can be made to the distribution box.

To address distribution box problems, common solutions include inspecting for clogs, repairing damaged components, and ensuring proper drainage.

In summary, the distribution box may encounter a variety of problems during operation, which not only affect the normal operation of the power system, but also may bring safety hazards.

For some reason, I cant find the issue why there is no power into the distribution box. The wire that is attached to the box near the fender, does have power to it.
