

What quota should be applied to the construction of new optical cable joints

Calculate optical margin for construction fiber links fast. Include connectors, splices, splitters, and cable attenuation easily. Compare results with required reserve and document compliance instantly.

Apply 501.15, 502.15, 505.16, or 506.16, as applicable [770.3 (A)]. You're not worried about flame propagating out of the fiber optic cable. You're worried about flame propagating past the cable, so ...

For optimum hauling performance, it is recommended that the cable-to-duct diameter fill ratio does not exceed 65% for pulling cable or 75% for blowing cable or as per the cable specification sheet.

If no specific recommendations are available from the cable manufacturer, the cable should not be pulled over a bend radius smaller than twenty (20) times the cable diameter.
