

What to do if there aren't enough optical ports on the aggregation switch

To ensure that the SFP ports are working properly, check your device for confirmation: The port LEDs should turn on and display a connection when the module and cable are inserted on both devices.

If the switch is shipped without SFP+ transceivers already installed, complete these steps to first install the transceivers and then to connect the cables.

It's not uncommon for a marginal cable to work at a step down in speed. You should still try to eliminate bad modules or switches/ports though. Probably easiest to take the cable in question out of the ...
