

Wireless cable tray not found

This article explain the necessary steps to restore a Wi-Fi icon not showing in the Windows system tray.

If the Network Icon (or Wireless icon) is missing from the Taskbar, you should always start by checking the System Tray to make sure that it is not hiding there.

Go to Settings > Update & Security > Troubleshoot > Additional troubleshooters > Internet Connections and run the troubleshooter. If these steps do not resolve the issue, you may ...

Expand the "Network adapters" section and look for any entries related to WiFi or wireless adapters. If you see any entries with a yellow exclamation mark, it indicates a problem with the driver ...
